The Skating Club at Dartmouth is a US Figure Skating member club. We offer the nationally recognized Snowplow Sam Program for skaters aged 3-5. Hockey skates are welcome. We have qualified and enthusiastic coaches that will help your child develop skating skills and confidence and, most importantly, have fun on the ice. Each of the sessions has a 30 minute lesson with an additional ten minutes of practice time/socialization time.

***Please note-Skaters registered for our Spring session are eligible to skate in our Annual Show. Please ask for details.

SCHEDULE

Thursdays 4:30-5:10 pm at Campion Rink – helmets are required. The first half-hour is a structured group lesson. The last ten minutes is practice time. This group lesson runs during our basic skills program.

The Skating Club reserves the right to cancel any program or alter the schedule if there is insufficient enrollment or coaching coverage or if necessary ice is not available.

UNITED STATES FIGURE SKATING & SCAD FEES

SCAD Registration Fee - \$60 (Sept 1, 2011 – Aug 31, 2012)

US Figure Skating Membership Fee - \$12 (July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012)

All skaters must pay an annual registration fee and the United States Figure Skating fee. The \$60 SCAD fee covers administrative costs, insurance and the club handbook for the SCAD season. The annual US Figure Skating fee provides basic membership to the national organization.

POLICIES

The following policies have been officially adopted by the Skating Club at Dartmouth. Please review them carefully before enrolling:

- There are no make-ups for missed sessions or cancelled ice or lessons.
- There are NO refunds made except for medical reasons. There are no refunds for cancelled ice or lessons.
- Helmets are required in the Pre-School program.
- Participants are required to have skates for each class.
- The Skating Club's Board of Directors requires that one parent or caregiver remain at the rink during pre-school sessions. Thank you for your cooperation.



- Skaters must have signed Emergency Forms and Waivers on file.

SCHOLARSHIPS & FAMILY DISCOUNTS

Please be advised - there is need-based scholarship assistance available through the Frannie Burnett Figure Skaters Scholarship Fund. This fund is committed to making figure skating financially accessible. Regardless of your experience or skating level, we encourage all with financial need to apply. Be assured that all inquiries, applications and awards are handled *confidentially*. The fund can assist with registration fees, private lessons and/or equipment.
